****IMPORTANT** READ BEFORE SIGNING APPLICATION**

Dates & Times

Summer Show – July 10 & 11

Fall Show – October 16 & 17

Saturday – 9:00 – 5:00

Sunday – 9:00 – 4:00

- Set-up will be from noon to 6:00 p.m. on Friday before the show and 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on Saturday for those wishing to set up the morning of the festival. On-site parking will be available in the festival grounds including space for cargo trailers but will not be adjacent to your booth.
- Set up and break down times will be enforced. No vehicles are allowed in the show area before the closing time.

Application

- **All applicants will be juried for the 2010 shows.** Applicants will be judged on a first come, first served basis. All applicants must submit photos, slides or digital images of all items to be sold in your booth. Photos, slides or CDs will not be returned.
- Payment must be submitted with applications. Your canceled check will be your only receipt. CHECKS RETURNED FROM THE BANK FOR ANY REASON WILL VOID YOUR SHOW ELIGIBILITY AND YOU WILL INCUR PENALTY FEES.
- Checks, photos, slides or digital images must be submitted with application or it will not be juried. Those not accepted will have booth fee checks returned.
- Each vendor is responsible for their own taxes.
- **Price Points** has been added to the application. (From lowest to Highest price of your merchandise) Please make sure that you fill in this new section.

Notification

- Letters of acceptance or denial will be sent out within 30 days of receipt of application.
- **Show directors reserve the right to deny any application without explanation.** We also reserve the right to remove any vendor violating the guidelines.

Entry Fees & Booth Size

All booths are 12x12 and will be set up in a quad pattern so that each vendor has two open sides.

July Show – 12x12 is \$100 if sent in by March 31st.
 12 x12 is \$125 if sent in after March 31st.
 Deadline for July show is June 15th

October Show 12X12 is \$100 if sent in by June 15th
 12x12 is \$125 if sent in after June 15th
 Deadline for October show is September 15th

- **Entry fee is non-refundable once accepted.** There will not be a rain date for the show should we have inclement weather.
- Should you leave before the show ends or you are a "no show", your name will be removed from our mailing list.
- No tables, chairs or electrical outlets are available to craft vendors.

Standards

- All items exhibited must represent the items presented in the application.
- **The following will not be allowed:** items purchased and put together, silk florals, resale items.
- No manufactured retail products may be sold.

Rules

- Due to the limited electricity service on the festival grounds, ANYONE in need of electricity should be prepared to provide for themselves. If you have a gasoline generator that you will be using, please inform us. Water is located by the rest room building. Each booth must be self-contained and independently operated.
- Overnight camping onsite is not allowed.
- Vendors are required to dispose of their own waste products in the provided dumpster. Trash receptacles that are placed around the grounds are for the customers use and convenience. **At festival close all materials & trash must be removed from your site and placed in the onsite dumpster.** Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed in dumpster. It is imperative that clean-up be thorough. Any vendor's assigned space left in disarray or with loose trash may forfeit their participation in any future festivals.

- Neither the Maggie Valley Chamber nor the Town of Maggie Valley will be held responsible for any damage to the property or persons participating in the shows.
